RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe (Tribe) recognizes the importance with providing protection for the physical, chemical, and biological integrity for surface waters within the PLPR, and provided for the ability to regulate habitat protection for plant and wildlife species dependent upon the Truckee River and Pyramid Lake water resources; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe shall seek funding for construction and maintenance of water development projects for the PLPR rangelands with the intent to stimulate growth in underutilized areas pursuant to the development of the Range Inventory/Rangeland Management Plans; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Natural Resources Department received notice from the Bureau of Indian Affairs Western Regional Office (BIA) on December 3, 2020 that it is requesting proposals for competitive Non-Base Funding for Range Projects for Fiscal Year 2021, with a proposal deadline of January 13, 2021; and
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council the governing body for the Pyramid Lake Tribe hereby approves the grant application proposal to request funding for the BIA competitive Non-Base Funding for Range Projects for FY 2021.
- **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED,** that the Tribal Chairperson or their designee is authorized to negotiate and execute said application with the Bureau of Indian Affairs Western Regional Office.
