RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for transitional housing for victims of Domestic Violence on the Reservation.

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe would benefit from the Transitional Housing Services that would be provided by a United States Department of Justice Transitional Housing Assistance Grant.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice is currently accepting applications to its Transitional Housing Assistance Grant.

WHEREAS, no match is required for this grant and full Indirect Costs are paid.


WHEREAS, the deadline to submit an application to the United States Department of Justice is February 12, 2020

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council authorizes the development of an application to the United States Department of Justice for Transitional Housing Assistance Grant in the Amount of \$500,000

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Chairman of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is authorized to sign all documents needed to submit an application for Transitional Housing Assistance Grant.
