## RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS, the Department of Justice is currently seeking applications for the Consolidated Tribal Assistance Solicitation Program.
- WHEREAS, these funds can be used to pay for police officers and patrol cars.
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe had a Community Policing Program in 2018, and that program provided positive results for victims and offenders.
- **WHEREAS,** the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council needs to hire two additional officers and purchase two patrol cars.
- **WHEREAS,** the \$700,000 being requested is enough to pay for the salaries and beenefits of the two officers for three years.
- WHEREAS, the Tribe will have five years from the date of the award to expend funds.
- **WHEREAS**, no match is required and full indirect costs are paid on this grant.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council approves an application to the Consolidated Tribal Assistance Solicitation Purpose Area #1 in the amount of \$700,000.
