RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe ("Tribe"), is organized pursuant to the Provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. 476) and is a Federally Recognized by the United State Government through the Secretary of the Interior to negotiate with Federal, State and local governments; and
- whereas, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, has an UPDATED Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP), dated May 10, 2018 and approved by Tribal Resolution PL 60-18, that contains transportation goals and objectives for the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation; and
- WHEREAS the goals and objectives in the LRTP include: the installation of lighting, walkways and bikeways for children and families living in the communities of Wadsworth, Sutcliff and Nixon, specifically near the Natchez Elementary School in Wadsworth; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe was recently awarded \$500,000.00 thousand dollars to construct a multiuse walking path between 8th street and 5th street in Wadsworth, Nevada adjacent to SR447 and across the street from Natchez Elementary School; and
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe plans to construct the multi-use walking path in partnership with Nevada Department of Transportation Safety Division, which will include overhead lighting, a paved walking path, new school zone flashers, crossing signals, new cross walks on SR447; and
- WHEREAS, a field inventory has been completed, and the required documents prepared, to add .38 miles of paved pathway, Tribal Route T200, Sections 010-040 in the National Tribal Transportation Facilities Inventory (NTTFI).
- **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves updating the Tribe's NTTFI to include the addition of Tribal Route T200, Sections 010-040, and authorizes the submission of required inventory update documents to facilitate this change.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Pyramid Lake Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Bureau of Indian Affairs Western Regional Office to take the necessary action needed to update the NTTFI database to incorporate Tribal Route T200, Section 010-040.

implement all administrative functions necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.
