## RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. Section § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe receives Tribal Transportation Program (TTP) funds through a Program Agreement for planning projects including the Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP); and
- **WHEREAS,** The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe has an existing Long- Range Transportation Plan updated 5/10/2018 and desires to update this plan;
- WHEREAS, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe desires to add a Multi-Use Walking Path located adjacent to State Route 447 in Wadsworth Nevada to our Long-Range Transportation Plan;
- **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves the attached Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe Updated Long Range Transportation Plan dated 2/21/2020 which includes the addition of the Multi Use Walking Path Project replacing any previous Long-Range Transportation Plan.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that this Long- Range Transportation Plan dated 2/21/2020 be submitted to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for inclusion in the BIA Transportation system.
