RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe wishes to become a Member Indian/Native Government in good standing with the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI); and
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe meets all requirements for Tribal membership, pursuant to Article III-Members, Section B of the Constitution and By-laws of NCAI.
- **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council, which is the official governing body of the above-named Tribe, hereby authorizes Anthony Sampson Sr., who is the official principal tribal official, to take the necessary action to place the Tribe in membership with NCAI.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that Tribal funds in the amount of \$1,300, based on the Tribal membership dues schedule in the NCAI By-laws, Article III-Members, Section C-2, are authorized to be paid for membership in the NCAI.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that based on enrollment of 2971 enrolled members, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe shall have 130 votes, in accordance with Article III-Members, Section B1(d).
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Pyramid Lake Tribal Council had a change in leadership during their February 7, 2020 Regular Council meeting; Tribal Councilmember Janet Davis replaced Vice Chairman Alan Mandell as an Alternate Delegate for the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe.
- **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that pursuant to Article III-Members, Section B1(b) of the NCAI Constitution and By-Laws, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council designates the following persons as Delegate and Alternate Delegate, and instructs them to become individual members in good standing with NCAI in order to fulfill their responsibilities as Official Delegates and Alternate Delegates to the National Congress of American Indians Annual Convention, Executive Council Winter Session and Mid-Year Conference:
