RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA


- WHEREAS,** the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS,** the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe declared a State of Emergency due to the COVID-19 outbreak of 2020.
- WHEREAS,** the Pyramid Lake Fire and Emergency Services Department is operating an Emergency Operations Center and has been since March 20, 2020.
- WHEREAS,** the Center for Disease Control and Prevention published a Notice of Funding Opportunity for their "Supporting Tribal Public Health Capacity in Coronavirus Preparedness and Response," grant program on April 2, 2020.
- WHEREAS,** given the available funding and number of potential applicants, the Tribe can expect to apply for up to \$70,000 and be awarded funds by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
- WHEREAS,** the grant can pay for personal protective equipment needed to prevent COVID-19 exposure among Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe Fire and Emergency Services Department Personnel during medical transport of patients.
- WHEREAS,** the grant can pay for operational costs associated with the Emergency Operations Center, including personnel costs.
- WHEREAS,** the emergency operations center provides important information to the public on what they can do to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 and coordinates the deployment of resources in response to the COVID-19 crisis.
- WHEREAS,** no match is required on this grant and full indirect costs are paid.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Pyramid Lake Tribal Council Authorizes an application in the amount of \$68,623 to the Center for Disease Control and Prevention Tribal COVID-19 Public Health Preparedness and Response Grant Program and authorizes the Chairman to sign all documents needed to submit the application.
