## **RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA**

- WHEREAS,** the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act, (25 U.S.C. 476) and is Federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior to negotiate with federal, state and local governments; and
- WHEREAS,** the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe has established the Tribal Cultural Resources Committee and the Tribal Historic Preservation Office; and
- WHEREAS,** to ensure cultural heritage preservation, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council has conferred with the Tribal Cultural Resources Committee and the Tribal Historic Preservation Office; and
- WHEREAS,** the U.S. Department of the Interior, National Park Service, Tribal Preservation Program, is accepting applications for funding under the CRFA-PGC Cultural Resources Financial Assistance program for fiscal year 2021-22; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Historic Preservation Officer on behalf of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe has developed an application to fund the Tribal Historic Preservation Office which carries out the duties and responsibility of the State Historic Preservation Officer on tribal lands, and works to preserve and protect historic properties, burial sites, sacred places, traditional cultural properties, traditional gathering locations, and archeological sites.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves, supports, and authorizes the submittal of the application to the U.S. National Park Service CFRA-PGC Cultural Resources Financial Assistance FY 2021-22

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** the Pyramid Lake Tribal Council authorizes the Tribal Chairwoman or her designee to negotiate and sign all grant awards and other future administrative documents necessary for project award and implementation.
