RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

WHEREAS, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act, (25 U.S.C. 476) and is Federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, currently receives annual funding (Tribal Shares) under the Tribal Transportation Program (TTP) for tribal Transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe has an approved Long Range Transportation Plan that lists the Transit Facility parking and access road project; and

WHEREAS, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe has an existing Tribal Transportation Improvement Program (TTIP), which identifies the Transit Facility parking and access road project; and

WHEREAS, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe received notification that \$210,357.47 are available under the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) for Highway Improvement Programs (HIP-CRRSA Funds); and

WHEREAS, Because of the rising cost of materials, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe desires to use the \$210,357.47 to supplement construction of PLIR P101(2) Transit Facilities Parking and Access Road project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves, supports, and authorizes \$210,357.47 of HIP-CRRSAA funds for the Transit Facility parking and access road construction.

CERTIFICATION

It is hereby certified that the foregoing resolution of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council, governing body of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, composed of ten members, of whom ten (10) constituting a quorum were present at a meeting duly held on the 20th day of May, 2021 was adopted by the affirmative vote of eight (8) FOR and zero (0) AGAINST, with one (1) ABSTENTIONS; pursuant to the authority contained in the Constitution and By-laws of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe.
