RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe recognizes the importance with providing protection for the quality of clean air for the Pyramid Lake Paiute Reservation communities and for its community residents for a cleaner, healthier environment and to improve air quality; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe received an award letter from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 9 dated May 14, 2021 indicating funding for the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe Clean Air Act Program for \$86,659 wherein it does not require a cash match; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Natural Resources Department Clean Air Act Program developed its scope of work, its supporting budget, and a workplan; and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council the governing body for the Pyramid Lake Tribe hereby approves the grant application to complete the grant application process for the EPA Region 9 competitive Air Quality Act Program funding for FY 2022; and
- **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED,** that the Tribal Chairperson or their designee is authorized to execute the application process with the EPA Region 9.
