RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

WHEREAS, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act, (25 U.S.C. 476) and is Federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, currently receives annual funding (Tribal Shares) under the Tribal Transportation Program (TTP) for tribal Transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe has an approved Long-Range Transportation Plan that lists the Complete Streets (Shared Use Path) project; and

WHEREAS, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe has an existing Tribal Transportation Improvement Program (TTIP), which identifies the Complete Streets (Shared Use Path) and

WHEREAS, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe has retained an engineering consultant to draft a right-of-way plat and legal description and;

WHEREAS, the said right-of-way being;


1. The Legal Description for the area and the Right-of-Way Drawing #PL-1-2, showing the area within Section 4, T.20N., R.24E., MDM containing 0.475+/- acres.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves, supports, and authorizes consent for a road Right-of-Way and Temporary Construction Easements (TCE"S) without the Bureau of Indian Affairs approval as identified on the attached drawing and legal description for the Complete Streets (Shared Use Path) Project construction.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairperson or their designee be authorized to negotiate, extend or amend this grant application as needed.

CERTIFICATION
