RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe (Tribe) recognizes the importance of improving bank stabilization for water quality and fish passage for Threatened Lahontan Cutthroat Trout (LCT) and Endangered Cui-ui fish in the main stem Truckee River; and
- WHEREAS, the Stream Bed at Mike O'Daye's property is a major source of sediment entering the river that impairs water quality and becomes a barrier to fish passage at the delta to access to 40.0 miles of stream habitat; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has the opportunity for restoration of this stream bank through funding provided by the Bureau of Reclamation, Native American Affairs Technical Assistance Program; and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council the governing body for the Pyramid Lake Tribe hereby approves the grant application for Bureau of Reclamation, Native American Affairs Technical Assistance Program; and
- **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED,** that the Tribal Chairperson or their designee is authorized to execute the application process with the EPA.
