## **RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA**

**WHEREAS**, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe,

**WHEREAS**, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, pursuant to Public Law 93-638, entered into an Annual Funding Agreement (contract no. A21AV00190) with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for maintenance of roads on the Indian Reservation Roads inventory; and

**WHEREAS**, The Bureau of Indian Affairs Western Regional Office notified the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe of an available funds to address maintenance operations on unpaved roads and bridges that are utilized by school buses to transport students; and

**WHEREAS**, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe's Road Maintenance department has identified three routes, that are utilized for the school bus transportation and are identified as, route 0004, route 0006, and route 12 need repair and will direct funding towards projects on those routes; and


**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves the acceptance of available funding from the Bureau of Indian Affairs Western Regional Office to address maintenance operations on unpaved roads and bridges that are utilized by school buses to transport students;

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that the Tribal Chairperson or their designee be authorized to negotiate, extend or amend this grant application as needed.

### ***CERTIFICATION***
