RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe,

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe wishes to approve the submission of the USDA Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations grant application (CFDA 10.567) for a total request of \$647,642. The Tribe is submitting a Cost Share Waiver Request. The budget breakdown is as follows: Startup costs \$301,882 (\$242,378 Direct Costs and \$59,504 Indirect Costs); Remainder of FY2021 \$49,740 (\$40,659 Direct Costs and \$9,081 Indirect Costs); FY2022 \$296,020 (\$242,520 Direct Costs and \$53,500 Indirect Costs).


WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe sees the importance of tribal food sovereignty for the tribal membership and community members. The FDPIR will keep a minimum of three months supply of food on hand for all participants in the program.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves the USDA Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations grant application in the total amount of \$647,642 as described above.
