RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe,

WHEREAS, certain aspects of Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR) policy are to be established by each individual Tribe administering the Program, namely, definition of temporary absences;


“Temporary Absences” – An individual may still be considered a household member during a temporary absence from home for such reasons as vacations, family emergencies, work trips, school breaks, etc. “Temporary absence” is defined as a being out of the home for a consecutive period of time ranging from 7 days to 30 days. An individual who is away from the home for more than 30 days must be removed from the household’s membership. In addition, as long as the temporarily absent household member remains on the household’s case, the temporarily absent household member cannot be added to and/or receive benefits from any other FDPIR or the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves the policy/definition of “Temporary Absences” for the purposes of the FDPIR Program being operated on the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Reservation.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council adopts, approves, and supports the policy/definition of “Temporary Absences” for use with the FDPIR, operating on the Pyramid Lake Paiute Reservation.

CERTIFICATION
