RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe,
- WHEREAS, certain aspects of the CARES ACT funding are to be utilized for food distribution to those individuals/families that are self-quarantining due to an active COVID case or possible exposure; the Pyramid Lake Food Distribution Program requests budget approval for anticipated expenses related to the COVID-19 Pandemic in the amount of \$150,000.
- **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that** the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves the proposed CARES ACT budget to be used in the delivery of groceries to those impacted by the COVID-19 Pandemic on the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Reservation.
- **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that** the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council adopts, approves, and supports the attached CARES ACT budget (in the amount of \$150,000) that will enable us to provide food to those individuals/families who are at home self-quarantining due to an active or possible exposure to COVID-19 on the Pyramid Lake Paiute Reservation.
