RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council is the duly elected governing body of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe charged with the responsibility of establishing policy and taking action to preserve and protect the health and general welfare of the Tribal membership; and
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, is authorized to manage its own accounts and funds; and
- WHEREAS, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe received funding through the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund established under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARP); and
- WHEREAS, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe recognizes that the American Rescue Plan Act identifies investments in Broadband Infrastructure as one of the main priorities that is of eligible use.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves, supports, and authorizes a portion of the American Rescue Plan funding to move forward with the implementation of Broadband Infrastructure.
- **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED,** that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council authorizes the Tribal Chairperson to execute the documents to achieve the intents and purposes of this Resolution.
