RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe (Tribe) Department of Natural Resources received the funding notice for Fiscal Year 2022 competitive non-recurring Agriculture Invasive Species Program (Noxious Weeds) grant that is administered by the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) Western Region Office; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has identified for control certain invasive weed and invasive tree species within the exterior boundaries of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Reservation (PLPR); and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribe has conducted annual operations working to build upon its effort to effectively address the seeding infestation along with the cause and source of invasive species' seeding within the exterior boundaries of the PLPR; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe is interested with its management effort to eradicate and reduce invasive plant species to the lowest level possible for the benefit of tribal natural resource management; and
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council the governing body for the Pyramid Lake Tribe hereby approves the grant application proposal to request funding for the BIA non-recurring Agriculture Invasive Species Program (Noxious Weeds) grant funding for FY 2022.
- **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED,** that the Tribal Chairperson or their designee is authorized to negotiate and execute said application with the Bureau of Indian Affairs Western Regional Office.
