## RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe,
- WHEREAS, certain aspects of the DHHS ARPA Stabilization Discretionary Grant through 2023 are to be used to mitigate COVID 19. The purchases and 4 ZONO systems within the Tribal Childcare Centers, the ZONO systems are a part of mitigating and preventing the spread of Covid-19 and is an ozone-based sanitizing appliance that meets these criteria. The CDF201 employs a heat unit to also kill lice and bedbugs. The request to purchase four ZONO units within the Tribal Child Care Centers will be budget at \$96,000.
- **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that** the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves the proposed DHHS ARPA Stabilization Discretionary budget to be used in the delivery of operable ZONO systems within the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Child Care Center.
- **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED,** the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council adopts, approves and supports the attached quote from Innovative Healthcare Solutions, LLC, to mitigate and prevent the spread of COVID-19.
