- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council is the duly authorized governing body of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe by the authority of Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, and
- **WHEREAS**, the Pyramid Lake Tribal Council is charged with the responsibility to preserve and protect the citizens of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe Reservation; and
- **WHEREAS,** The U.S. Department of Agriculture is currently seeking applications for Equipment and Technology grant
- WHEREAS, The Pyramid Lake Police Department is requesting to submit an application for \$50,000.00 which would cover 75% of the cost to purchase and upfit a new Police K-9 vehicle.
- **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council, hereby approves the application to the U.S.D.A. to purchase / upfit one Police K-9 vehicle for a total fund award of \$50,000.00
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Tribal Chairperson or their designee is hereby authorized to sign the grant application.
