RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe,


WHEREAS, certain aspects of the Department of Health & Human Services (DHHS) Child Care Development Funds (CCDF) FY21 American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding are to be used for funding. To purchase teaching strategies for early childhood within the Tribal Child Care Centers, the Teaching Strategies Database Curriculum meets this criteria for health and safety/social and emotional/family database curriculum. The request for The Teaching Strategies Database Curriculum with the Tribal Child Care Centers will be budgeted at \$33,075.00.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves the proposed Department of Health & Human Services FY21 American Rescue Plan Act budget to be used in the delivery of the Teaching Strategies Curriculum Database.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council adopts, approves and supports the attached quote from Teaching Strategies to mitigate and prevent the spread of COVID 19.
