RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe,

WHEREAS, with the adoption of Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe Resolution PL 66-08, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe recognized the importance to provide protection for the physical, chemical, and biological integrity within the PLIR, and provided for the ability to regulate habitat protection for plant and wildlife species dependent upon the Truckee River and Pyramid Lake water resources; furthermore,

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recognizes the need for water engineers for protecting the water rights and to facilitate water management activities with other TROA parties and Stetson Engineers is the contractor used by the Tribe for many years and is in good standing with the Tribal Council; furthermore,

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe shall seek technical assistance and funding for the water engineers to develop Tribal water conservation and management plans to promote the health of water resources on the reservation.


WHEREAS, the Bureau of Reclamation's Native American Affairs Program funding proposal will fund work completed by Stetson Engineers for water resources of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves, supports, and authorizes the submittal of the funding proposal Fiscal Year 2022 Bureau of Reclamation Native American Affairs Program.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Tribal Chairperson or designee is hereby authorized to negotiate and sign all grant awards and other future administrative documents necessary for project award and implementation.

CERTIFICATION

It is hereby certified that the foregoing resolution of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council, governing body of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, composed of ten members, of whom nine (9) constituting a quorum were present at a meeting duly held on the 16th day of March 2022, was adopted by the affirmative vote of seven (7) FOR and zero (0) AGAINST, with one (1) ABSTENTIONS; pursuant to the authority contained in the Constitution and By-laws of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe.
