## RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe (Tribe), pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe recognizes the importance of providing protection for the quality of the environment for the Pyramid Lake Paiute Reservation (Reservation) natural resources and for its communities; and
- WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has issued a Notice of Funding Opportunity for funds under the American Rescue Plan related to tribal air quality programming; and
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Tribal Air Monitoring Program maintains air quality PM10 monitoring stations on the Reservation and makes its data publicly available; and
- WHEREAS, the additional air quality monitoring needs have been identified by the Pyramid Lake Natural Resources Department that our Reservation is underrepresented for PM 2.5 air quality monitoring and data collection; and
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Tribal Air Monitoring Program has prepared and included fine particulate matter (PM2.5) monitoring project for funding with this proposal; and
- WHEREAS, this notice of funding opportunity announces that this grant does not require a cash match; and
- WHEREAS, the application deadline is March 25, 2022; and
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves the grant application to be submitted for the competitive United States American Rescue Plan funding for the air quality program.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED,** that the chairperson or designee is authorized to execute the application process with EPA.
