## **RESOLUTION NO.: PL 061-22**

*FTA – FY22 Bus & Bus Facilities Competitive Program Grant  
One New Bus & Rehabilitation of Two Existing Buses*

### **RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA**

- WHEREAS**, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS**, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe;
- WHEREAS**, the Federal Transit Administration has been authorized to provide funding to support public transportation under 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53;
- WHEREAS**, grants or cooperative agreements for Federal financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe and may require the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe to provide the non-Federal share of transportation-related expenses supported with Federal financial assistance;
- WHEREAS**, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is legally authorized under Federal, state, or local law to apply for and receive Federal assistance;
- WHEREAS**, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe has the authority to apply for and receive Buses and Bus Facilities Competitive Program (FTA-002-TPM) authorized by 49 U.S.C. 5307;
- WHEREAS**, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe has the authority to apply for and receive Formula Grants for Rural Areas Program under 49 U.S.C. 5311;
- WHEREAS**, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is a Federally-recognized tribe under the Department of Interior's annual notice in the Federal Register;
- WHEREAS**, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is required to provide certain certifications and assurances to the Federal Transit Administration at least annually;
- WHEREAS**, 1. That Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Transit or designee is authorized to execute and file an application for Federal assistance on behalf of Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe with the Federal Transit Administration for Federal assistance authorized by 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53 or any other Federal statutes authorizing activities administered by the Federal Transit Administration. 2. That the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is authorized to execute the grant and cooperative agreements with

the Federal Transit Administration on behalf of Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Chairwoman, is authorized to execute and file the ***FY2022 Buses and Bus Facilities Competitive Program*** competitive grant application with the Department of Transportation DOT/Federal Transit Administration on behalf of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe and that the Tribal Chairwoman or designee be authorized to negotiate, extend or amend this grant application as needed for the purpose of obtaining one (1) new bus and rehabilitate two (2) existing buses.
