## RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. Section § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, on December 18, 2015 enacted a Strategic Transportation Safety Plan through resolution PL 105-15 which has served as a guiding document for transportation safety projects; and
- WHEREAS, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe Transportation Planning department is seeking funds from Federal Highways Tribal Transportation Safety Fund in the amount of \$10,000.00 (no match required) to update the plan with public input and additional elements as recommended by federal highways safety planning guidelines; and
- **WHEREAS**, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe recognizes the need for planning documents to guide the work of the departments that the administration oversees and supports the submission of this grant request;
- **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Chairperson or designee to submit a Transportation Safety Plan Update Grant in the amount of \$10,000.00; and

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Tribal Chairperson or designee be authorized to negotiate, extend or amend this grant application as needed.
