## RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act, (25 U.S.C. 476) and is Federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior; and

whereas, the Department of the Interior's Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) is soliciting for eligible projects under its – Water Management, Planning, and Pre-development grant to approve all eligible projects for funding considerations and obtain funding for water resources management on Indian Trust lands for the benefit of The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the grant program Water Management, Planning and Pre-Development allows funding for Tribal Water Management programs for the purpose of managing, conserving, and utilizing Tribal Water Resources; and

WHEREAS, the Water Management funding will protect the waters of Pyramid Lake, the Lower Truckee River and the Fishery; and

**WHEREAS,** the proposal being submitted is consistent with planning and development efforts on the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation for the betterment of the Tribe and its members.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Pyramid Lake Tribal Council hereby approves, supports, and authorizes the submittal of the proposal to the Bureau of Indian Affairs – Water Management, Planning, and Pre-Development,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Tribal Chairperson or designee is hereby authorized to negotiate and sign all grant awards and other future administrative documents necessary for project award and implementation,

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED THAT,** The Pyramid Lake Tribal Council hereby requests that this funding be added to the existing Water Resources 638 contract.
