RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, the Tribe agrees to create a new restricted use, roll over line item in the Emergency Response Program budget (Fund Code 122) utilizing monies received from the GEMT Settlement and funds from Surplus equipment sales from the Emergency Response Program for the restricted purpose of replacing worn out fire department vehicles, such as Staff Vehicles, Ambulances and/or Fire Apparatus.

WHEREAS, these restricted funds cannot be used for any other purposes within the Emergency Response budget. However, the GEMT and Surplus funds will be calculated towards the departments projected revenues and placed into the restricted line item.


WHEREAS, use of the restricted line item will require approval of the Tribal Council in accordance with Tribal policy.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves the creation of this specific restricted budgetary line item for the Emergency Response Program (fund code 122).
