RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council is the duly authorized governing body of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe by the authority of Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Tribal Council is charged with the responsibility to preserve the history and culture of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada Arts Council is currently seeking applications for the 2023 Native American Initiative Grant; and


WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Museum is requesting to submit a grant application for \$5,000.00 which would support the transmission and presentation of traditional art forms that are practiced, valued and shared within the Native American communities in Nevada and bring artists, cultural specialists and communities together; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council, hereby approves the application to the Nevada Arts Council for 2023 Native American Initiative Grant in the amount of \$5,000.00

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tribal Chairperson or designee is hereby authorized to sign the grant application.

CERTIFICATION

It is hereby certified that the foregoing resolution of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council, governing body of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, composed of ten members, of whom ten (10) constituting a quorum were present at a meeting duly held on the 6th day of January 2023, was adopted by the affirmative vote of eight (8) FOR and zero (0) AGAINST, with one (1) ABSTENTIONS; pursuant to the authority contained in the Constitution and By-laws of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe.
