
## **RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA**

- WHEREAS,** the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS,** the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe,
- WHEREAS,** with the adoption of Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe Resolution PL 66-08, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe recognized the importance to provide protection for the physical, chemical, and biological integrity within the PLIR, and provided for the ability to regulate habitat protection for plant and wildlife species dependent upon the Truckee River and Pyramid Lake water resources; furthermore,
- WHEREAS,** the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe shall seek technical assistance and funding for the development of Tribal conservation and management plans to promote the maintenance, restoration, enhancement, and health of ecosystems upon wildlife depends.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED,** the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe supports the submission of the FY 2023 Bureau of Indian Affairs Invasive Species grant application, entitled Pyramid Lake Paiute Reservation Feral Horse and Burro Program.

### **CERTIFICATION**
