RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

WHEREAS,

the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act, (25 U.S.C. 476) and is Federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior to work with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS,

the Bureau of Indian Affairs is soliciting for eligible projects under its – Fisheries, Wildlife, and Recreation Program to approve all eligible projects for funding considerations and obtain funding for the Management Noxious Weeds on Indian Trust lands for the benefit of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS,

the grant program provides funding to plan for the development of planning, management, and implementation documents and procedures to manage existing noxious weed species issues, or to develop procedures to prevent noxious weeds from impacting tribal trust resource where such species are not already established; and

WHEREAS,

the management of the noxious weeds on the Pyramid Lake Reservation would allow the tribe to provide better aquatic and terrestrial environments and reduce impacts on the Fishery and other Tribal Trust Resources; and

Whereas,

the proposal being submitted is consistent with planning, development, and implementation efforts towards other restoration and river resources on the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation for the betterment of the Tribe and its members.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal council hereby approves, supports, and authorizes the submittal of the proposal to the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Noxious Weed Program Grant to perform tasks to be incorporated in the Noxious Weed Grant Proposal for the Pyramid Lake Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tribal Chairman or his designee by hereby authorized to negotiate and sign all grant awards and other future administrative documents necessary for project award and implementation.
