RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. Section § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and,
- WHEREAS, the governing body of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe of Nevada, Tribal Council is organized under the provisions of the said Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.98), is responsible for the promotion of cultural, economic and social welfare of its tribal members; and,
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe has a Long-Range Transportation Plan that contains transportation goals and objectives for the Tribe; and,
- WHEREAS, one of the goals and objectives is the development of a "rails to trails" bicycle & pedestrian trail along the western shore of Pyramid Lake; and,
- **WHEREAS,** the transportation planning study, National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and preliminary engineering have been completed and,
- **WHEREAS,** a Transportation Alternatives Programs (TAP) grant through NDOT is available to fund completion of the final design and construction of the bike path and
- WHEREAS, Tribal Transportation has the 5% match funds (\$466,667.00) added to grant funds (\$9,333,333.00) to equal the estimated \$9,800,000.00 cost to complete the five (5) mile phase one (1) from Sutcliffe to the new proposed bike path bridge at Mullins Creek, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves and authorizes the application for the Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) grant for completion of phase one (1) of the PLIR T100 (1) Tahoe-Pyramid Bike Path.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Council authorizes the Tribal Chairman or designee to execute any and all documents necessary to facilitate the intent of this resolution.
