RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, has established the Pyramid Lake Board of Education (Board of Education) to plan, develop and administer an accredited academic program of the Pyramid Lake Jr./Sr. High School; and,


WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Tribal Council is authorized to delegate authority to the Board of Education for the overall administration of the Pyramid Lake Jr./Sr. High School to fulfill grant and financial compliance to meet the overall program goals and objectives; and

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Tribal Council has reviewed the Request to Waive 1.2 of Title 25 of Code of Federal Regulations, subchapter E for this School Year, 2020-2021 as recommended by the School Board and the Bureau of Indian Education's (BIE) letter received on September 16, 2020 with a submittal deadline of September 30; the waiver is due to the COVID-19 pandemic that occurred in 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves the Pyramid Lake Jr./Sr. High School's request to submit their letter to waive Section 1.2 of Title 25 CFR, subchapter E regulatory requirements for the fall of School Year 2020-2021.
