## RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, has established the Pyramid Lake Board of Education (Board of Education) to plan, develop and administer an accredited academic program of the Pyramid Lake Jr./Sr. High School; and,
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Tribal Council is authorized to delegate authority to the Board of Education for the overall administration of the Pyramid Lake Jr./Sr. High School to fulfill grant and financial compliance to meet the overall program goals and objectives; and
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Tribal Council has reviewed the Request to Waive 1.2 of Title 25 of Code of Federal Regulations, subchapter E for this School Year, 2020-2021 as recommended by the School Board and the Bureau of Indian Education's (BIE) letter received on September 16, 2020 with a submittal deadline of September 30; the waiver is due to the COVID-19 pandemic that occurred in 2020.
- **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby approves the Pyramid Lake Jr./Sr. High School's request to submit their letter to waive Section 1.2 of Title 25 CFR, subchapter E regulatory requirements for the fall of School Year 2020-2021.
