## RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs to negotiate with federal, state, and local governments; and
- WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council has a budgetary process designed to ensure fiscal accountability by all Tribal programs and services and to provide for all the allocation of the Tribe's financial revenues on an annual basis; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe's Comptroller has submitted the recommendation to the Tribal Council for adoption and implementation of the operating budget amount of all General Funded Tribal Programs and services, and establishing allocations to individual programs in the upcoming calendar (fiscal) year.

WHEREAS, the fund code 074 used by Child Care will not be funded with General Funds.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the FY2021 budget of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Funded Programs for \$5,300,000.00 and the Indirect Funded Programs for \$2,918,020.50 is hereby approved as submitted;

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that the budget and allocation approval adopted by the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council for CY2021 shall become effective on January 1, 2021.
