## RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council declared a State of Emergency on March 20, 2020.

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe has been significantly impacted by COVID-19, including 111 cases and two fatalities in the community at the time of the writing of this resolution.

WHEREAS, 638 Contracts provide a substantial portion of the Tribe's operational budget and provide services to members, services that are needed more than ever due to the COVID-19 Pandemic.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council authorizes an application to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the Following 638 Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs:

Minerals and Mining A16AV00689

and

Technical Support for Flood Control, TROA-Memorandum of Agreement, and TROA Implementation including OCAP and Recoupment

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chairman is authorized to sign all documents needed to submit an application.
