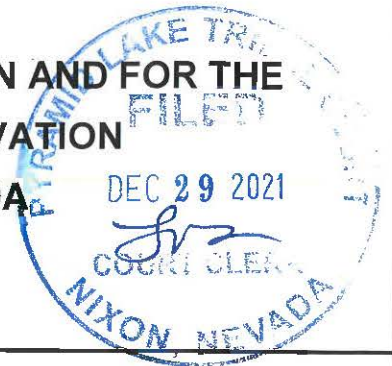

IN RE BAIL SCHEDULE:

ORDER SETTING BAIL

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. All previous Bail Schedule Orders are hereby rescinded.
2. That in accordance with Title III, Pyramid Lake Law & Order Code (as amended September 6, 2019) section 3.4.345(J), the following is established and shall be implemented as the standing *Order of the Court Re: Bail Schedule* and shall be in effect upon the recommendation of the Law and Order Committee to Tribal Council for approval.
3. Tribal prisoners, unless otherwise ordered, shall be allowed to post the cash bail listed in the following bail schedule and be released without any action by the Pyramid Lake Tribal Court.
4. All Officers, Jailors and or Officials shall use the following bail schedule when booking prisoners.

BAIL SCHEDULE

1. Class A Offenses Bail: \$750.00 with the following exception:
 - a. Any person charged with the following Class A Offenses shall be subject to a NO BAIL HOLD pending initial appearance in court:

3.4.400 Homicide	3.4.404 Aggravated Assault	3.4.408 Aggravated Battery
3.4.410 Sexual Battery	3.4.420 Kidnapping	3.4.426 Rape 1 st Degree

3.4.432 Open or Gross Lewdness 2 nd Offense		

2. Class B Offenses Bail: \$600.00
3. Class C Offenses Bail: \$375.00

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

Per 3.09.406 (1) No person arrested for the crime of domestic violence or violation of an order for protection shall be released from jail until after the expiration of 48 hrs. from arrest.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That bail for any violation under 3.4.640 (A-F) Fireworks Offense shall be set at \$185.00 per offense.
