RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

- WHEREAS, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provision of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 US Code, Subsection 476) of June 18,1934 and is a federally recognized Tribe by the United States government with powers of self government; and
- WHEREAS, The Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council, the Tribe's governing body, is empowered to enter into contracts and agreements and, pursuant to its inherent and retained sovereignty, has the authority to acquire tribal land in the name of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, a federally recognized Indian Tribe, and to provide for the sale or conveyance of tribal land; and
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby authorizes and approves the acquisition, by donation, from the Washoe County School District of a 0.739 acre parcel located at 200 School Street in Wadsworth, Nevada, known as Washoe County APN 084-200-37, containing the Natchez School Gymnasium; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized to approve and execute any and all necessary documents, expend necessary funds, and to take such other actions as may be necessary or appropriate to accomplish the acquisition of said property as hereby approved by the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council in the name of and on behalf of the PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE OF THE PYRAMID LAKE RESERVATION, NEVADA, a federally recognized Indian Tribe.
