ATTENTION: THIS PACKET IS NOT A SUBSTITUE FOR THE ADVICE OF AN ATTORNEY OR ADVOCATE. COUNSEL IS ALWAYS RECOMMENDED FOR LEGAL MATTERS.

The laws governing the Pyramid Lake Paiute Reservation allow any person to represent him/herself in any legal action heard in the Pyramid Lake Tribal Court. However, filing Petitions/Application/Complaints with the Court and representing yourself in the Courtroom can involve complex legal matters. This packet only addresses a few legal issues involved in bringing your matter before Court.

When appearing pro se, Latin for "on one's own behalf", you are responsible for understanding the law that governs your case and for filing the correct legal documents. The laws and rules are set out in the Pyramid Lake Law & Order Code, the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, and the Pyramid Lake Tribal Court Operational Procedures.

When you return to the Court and sign these documents for filing, the Court assumes that all documents are read carefully and all potential outcomes of litigation in this matter are understood.

4	support of your request.
5	7. Please be advised if the Application is SIGNED by the Legal Advocate, this indicates that
6	Advocate is representing the Applicant in this Case.
7	8. The last page must be completely filled out, as the Court staff are not locators of
8	addresses. Please state mailing and physical addresses as this is necessary for proper
9	service of Petition. **PLEASE BE ADVISED: We cannot and will not look into the Court
10	management System to locate an address, as it is your responsibility.**
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12	REQUIREMENTS OF ISSUANCE OF TEMPORARY AND EXTENDED ORDERS (3.09.702):
12	• The application <u>MUST</u> prove that an act of domestic violence has occurred OR a
	threat exists of domestic violence.
14	• The person who the domestic violence happened to needs to be the one who files;
15	you can NOT file on behalf of someone.
16	• A <u>TEMPORARY ORDER</u> may be granted without notice & hearing if the Court finds an
17	emergency.
18	• An <i>EXTENDED ORDER</i> may ONLY be granted <u>after</u> notice to the adverse party and a
19	hearing has been held.
20	The Court may grant the following relief <u>WITHOUT</u> notice and a hearing if an
21	emergency exists (The same relief may be granted in a permanent order for protection
22	or modification of permanent order):
23	\circ Order the Respondent from threatening to commit or committing acts of
24	Domestic Violence against the Petitioner. Any designated family member
25	and/or household member;
26	\circ Prohibit the Respondent from harassing, annoying, telephoning contacting, or
27	otherwise communicating with the petitioner directly or indirectly through
28	friends, relatives, or co-workers;

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1	\circ Remove and exclude the Respondent from the residence of the PETITONER;
2	regardless of ownership of the residence or lessee of record;
3	\circ $$ Order the Respondent to Stay away from the residence, school, or place of
4	employment of the Petitioner;
5	\circ $$ Seize and prohibit the Respondent from using or possessing a firearm or other $$
6	weapons specified by the Court;
7	\circ $$ Order possession of the parties' residence and use of any vehicle and other $$
8	essential personal effect, regardless of ownership;
9	\circ May direct Law Enforcement to accompany the Petitioner to the residence of
10	the parties to ensure the Petitioner is safely restored to the possession of the
11	residence, vehicle, and other personal effects;
12	\circ May direct Law Enforcement to Accompany the Respondent to retrieve their
13	belongings from the residence;
14	• The Court has up to seventy-two (72) hours to rule on an application after filing
15	(3.09.702(4)).
16	• Permanent Orders for Protection shall be issued for <i>not less than</i> Three (3) years.
17	(3.09.703)
18	• If there is an Emergency and an Order issued without notice, then a hearing <u>MUST</u> be
19	scheduled within 14 days of issuance (3.09.704(1)).
20	• If the Respondent is in custody, he will be served with the Protection Order at arraignment
	or before being released from detention. 3.09.704(3))
21	• If the Respondent is not able to be served at the last known address the Judge shall ask
22	the Applicant <u>under oath</u> at the hearing for the permanent protection order if he knows the
23	whereabouts of the Respondent or if he believes the Respondent is avoiding service. If
24	yes, the hearing will be continued within 14 days and the Clerk will serve the Respondent
25	by mail to the last and best-known address of the Respondent. The Ex-Parte Order will
26	remain in effect during this time. (3.09.704(4))
27	Any Respondent may petition the Court for reconsideration of the Order for Protection
28	showing, by CLEAR AND CONVIENCING evidence, that the Respondent did not

1	WILFULLY and KNOWINGLY evade service and that there is meritorious defense to the
2	action. If shown a hearing will be scheduled within 14 days. (3.09.704(6))
3	• If the Court denies the Emergency Petition for Order of Protection, the Court will inform
4	the Petitioner by mail and in person of their continuing right to request a hearing upon
5	notice to the Respondent. The Court will state why the request was denied. (3.09.704(7)).
6	• 3.09.705 Petitioner cannot violate Order for Protection: If the Respondent is excluded
7	from a location and the Petitioner invites the Respondent and the Respondent accepts it
8	DOES NOT waive or nullify the Order for Protection. Further, if the Petitioner invites the
9	respondent, it is <i>NOT</i> a violation of the Order for Protection.
10	• The Court will <i>NOT</i> grant mutual order for protection, ex parte or permanent order to
11	opposing parties. (3.09.707))
