I UNDERSTAND and AGREE that if any of the foregoing statements are not true or if I fail to carry out the agreements or conditions and land use plan contained in the application or with the approval of said assignment, that the assignment shall be subject to revocation by the Pyramid Lake Tribal Council.

If for some reason the plan is not adhered to in the time stated in the plan, the applicant may agree to discuss changes in the plan if asked to do so or request an extension to the plan with agreement of the Land & Resource Committee.

• Land assignment for a homesite- can be up to 1 acre.



### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. The application for land assignment shall be signed by the applicant and the witnesses.
- 2. Verification of your tribal enrollment and of the successors is required. Page 3.
- 3. All applications submitted must contain a Land Use Plan.
- 4. File your application with the Tribal Secretary with attached map and description of desired plot of land. Incomplete applications will be returned to the applicant and delay the process.
- 5. The application shall be posted at three (3) conspicuous locations on the Pyramid Lake Reservation for not less than twenty (20) days. The designated posting places are as follows:
  - a. The Tribal Administration Building/Lobby Nixon
  - b. US Post Office Nixon
  - c. US Post Office Wadsworth
  - d. Tribal Ranger Station Sutcliffe
- 6. Any member of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe wishing to oppose the granting of the assignment shall present in writing their opposition and deliver to the Tribal Secretary within the said posting period.
- 7. After the required posting period, the application will be reviewed at the next regularly scheduled Land & Resource Committee meeting.
