RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (25 U.S.C. § 476) and is federally recognized by the United States Government through the Secretary of the Interior and the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, Public Law 101-618, Title II, the Truckee-Carson-Pyramid Lake Water Rights Settlement Act, includes principal and interest amounts in the Pyramid Lake Paiute Economic Development Fund ("Fund") to support the Pyramid Lake Paiute Economic Development Plan ("Plan"); and

WHEREAS, in 2018, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe ("Tribe") withdrew assets that have been managed in accordance with the Plan through the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe Economic Development Fund Trust and the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe Economic Development Minors Trust ("Trusts"), utilizing the recordkeeping and administration services of FuturePlan and the custodial services of Nevada Trust Company; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe now elects to make changes to these services, utilizing Providence First Trust Company for the recordkeeping and administration, and Charles Schwab for the custodian.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribe now elects to make changes to these services, utilizing Providence First Trust Company for the recordkeeping and administration, and Charles Schwab for the custodian.
