RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE PYRAMID LAKE PAIUTE TRIBE NIXON, NEVADA

WHEREAS, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe is organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (25 USC, §476), and is Federally recognized by the U.S. Government through the Secretary of the Interior and Bureau of Indian Affairs; and,

WHEREAS, under Article II of the Constitution and By-Laws, the Tribe has the power to propose ordinances governing the membership and adoption of members into the Tribe, provided that no existing property of rights be affected; and,

WHEREAS, Ordinance I, Ordinance II, Ordinance 1-89, Ordinance III and Ordinance III (First Revision) have been adopted by the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe governing membership in the Tribe.

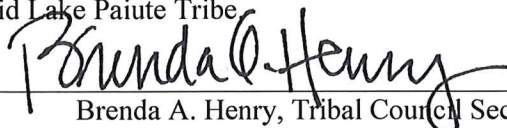
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, in accordance with Ordinance III (First Revision), Article VII, the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council hereby acknowledges the voluntary relinquishment of the following individual:

Madison Frances-Makenzie Craig – PL Member No. 03592

Said Relinquishment shall be effective upon approval of membership with The Confederated Tribes and Bands of the Yakama Nation. Notice shall be given that all rights and privileges afforded to the above-named individual as a member of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe are hereby relinquished. The name shown above shall be removed from membership in the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe and will not appear on any subsequent membership rolls of the Tribe from this date forth, provided the above-named is accepted for membership with The Confederated Tribes and Bands of the Yakama Nation.

CERTIFICATION

It is hereby certified that the foregoing Resolution of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal Council, governing body of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, composed of 10 members of whom ten (10), constituting a quorum, were present at a meeting duly held on the 2nd day of July 2026, was adopted by affirmative vote of nine (9) FOR, and zero (0) AGAINST; with zero (0) ABSTENTIONS; pursuant to the authority contained in the Constitution and By-Laws of the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe.
