

BURNING MAN TEMPORARY BUSINESS PERMIT

GARBAGE COLLECTION RULES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The purpose of this permit is to ensure that public health and safety is held in the highest regard and that all reasonable measures are taken to ensure that the public and Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal membership is not harmed by any Tribally permitted Garbage Collection site.

- The Garbage Collection Permit is valid only from **08/15 to 09/15**.
- Only Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribal members with a Tribal ID will be allowed to operate a Garbage Collection Site.
- Only Tribally licensed Garbage Collection Sites will be allowed. Signage stating such must be picked up at the PLPT Business Office.
- All waste and containers will be removed from the identified collection site by the end date of this permit.
- Anyone handling solid waste will have received the proper immunizations to prevent infection from disease. (Hepatitis A & B and Tetanus)
- Only acceptable waste will be collected.
 - ***Acceptable Waste defined:*** General Residential Waste such as durable & non-durable goods, containers and packaging, food waste, cans and bottles, paper waste, and miscellaneous inorganic waste.
 - ***Unacceptable Waste defined:*** Hazardous waste, Household Hazardous Materials (HHM), Medical Waste, Human Feces & Urine.
- Permittee agrees to be responsible for the safe transport and disposal of all collected solid waste.
 - Safe Transport is defined as: Storage and collection in Open to Roll-Off or Covered (Recycling) Roll-off Containers of adequate size and construction to prevent waste from coming into contact with the ground and allow for vector control.
 - Roll-off containers must be kept at least **300 feet** from any food vending area.
 - Storage of solid waste is temporary, and all solid waste must be transported off the reservation for disposal.
 - Tribal Transfer Stations are not to be used for disposal of solid waste collected during the permitted period.
- Roll-Off Container Location
 - Roll-off containers must be placed in a location and manner that does not create nuisances or potential health hazards, conditions or odors.
 - Roll-off containers must be placed at a minimum of twenty-five (25') feet from any public right-of-way.
 - **In no instance will any clearing of any vegetation or alteration/leveling of existing site conditions be allowed.**
